Western Early Keyboard Association

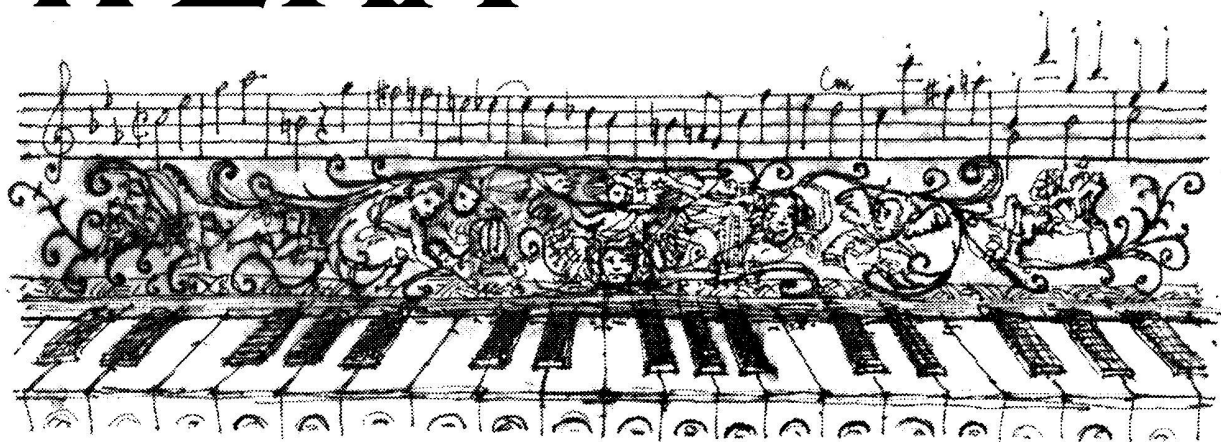

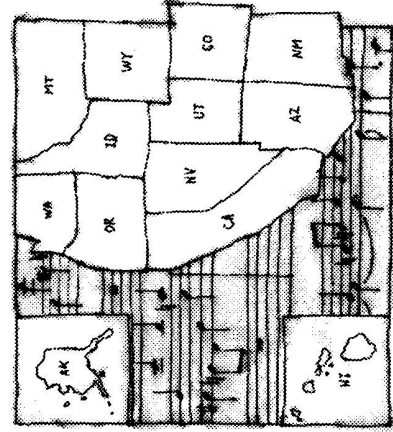
